- Challenges in linking the information to practice and/or the specific patient








Development



#### About Capacity

Matters related to capacity are considered when a person's ability to make decisions related to such person's property and personal care arise:

#### Decisions Related to Property

- Section 6 of the Substitutes Decisions Act ("SDA") provides that "A person is incapable of managing property if the person is not able to understand information that is relevant to making a decision in the management of his or her property, or is not able to appreciate the reasonably foreseeable consequences of a decision or lack of decision."
- · Decisions related to Property may address, but are not limited to, investments, estates, expenses and benefits.

#### Decisions Related to Personal Care:

- Section 45 of the SDA provides that "A person is incapable of personal care if the person is not able to
  understand information that is relevant to making a decision concerning his or her own health care, nutrition,
  shelter, clothing, hygiene or safety, or is not able to appreciate the reasonably foreseeable consequences of a
  decision or lack of decision"
- Decisions related to personal care may address, but are not limited to, healthcare, nutrition, clothing, hygiene, shelter, and safety.
- An individual whose capacity is under review may have capacity to make personal care decisions in some
  instances and lack the ability to make decisions in other instances.
