With continuous upgrades and the introduction of new products and services, continuous training and re-training is an essential aspect of having a practice that uses an electronic medical record (EMR) and other types of information technology. At St Michael's Hospital Academic Family Health Team, we have created several approaches to EMR and information technology (IT) staff development, including the formation of an interprofessional IT committee that meets regularly, a blog with EMR/IT information on our organizations's internal website, monthly eBulletins to our staff email listserve, and "hands-on" workshops for our faculty. This session will provide an overview of each of these different approaches to EMR/IT staff development along with a discussion of how feedback received from our staff has shaped our educational strategies.
