OMD conducted its 100th COVaxON live training session last month! Over the 100 sessions, OMD staff trained 2,689 physicians, nurses, clinic staff, and others who vaccinated Ontarians. Backdated COVID-19 Reports: Paused Delivery



From March 25 to 28, Health Report Manager (HRM®) began delivering backdated COVID-19 vaccination reports (i.e., reports NOT entered into COVaxON at the time the vaccine was administered) to your EMR. Due to issues with dose information, delivery has been paused until further notice. This doesn't affect the delivery of your other HRM reports, including the real-time COVID-19 vaccination reports. eForms: Helping to Axe the Fax!



Are you tired of filling out paper forms and faxing them to various organizations? OMD is working with the Ontario Ministry of Transportation (MTO) as a first step to automate the cumbersome form filling process. We've started with 32 common MTO forms (16 each for English and French) and two EMRs (YES EMR and YMS EMR), and we're moving ahead with more eForms! Say goodbye to faxed MTO forms! Drug Information in Your EMR: Countdown to November

Get access to the provincial repository that gives you information on publicly funded drugs and pharmacy services, monitored drugs, and COVID-19 vaccination information right from your EMR. EMR vendors were informed of the requirement to make drug information available through their certified EMRs by November 2022. Are You Moving? HRM Needs to Know Where You Are!

Just like the post office, HRM needs to know where to deliver your reports. Moving? Switching Internet providers? Changing your Internet plan? Choosing a new EMR provider? These scenarios could potentially mean a change to your IT delivery address disrupting your HRM feed and stopping your reports from hospitals and specialty clinics. HRM only delivers to locations it trusts, so don't forget to notify OMD at support@ontariomd.com when making a change. We need a minimum of

7 business days from the time we receive your complete request with a <u>valid</u> IP address to ensure you don't experience any disruptions to report
