University Health Network (UHN), Mount Sinai Hospital and Women's College Hospital have added diagnostic reports to the report types they are delivering to clinicians' EMRs. Clinicians started receiving diagnostic reports for their patients since January 25. <u>Check out all the report types</u> sent by these hospitals. Simply type their names in the search box.

Changes to Hospital Information Systems – Impact on HRM

Many Ontario hospitals are upgrading their Hospital Information Systems (HIS). This may result in the suspension of the HRM feed if there are issues with the transition from the old HIS to the new one. If this happens, the hospital will contact you to let you know about this temporary disruption of report delivery from the hospital through HRM to your EMR and when report delivery is expected to resume. Allergy Advice for the COVID-19 Vaccine is Now Available on the Ontario eConsult Service

Physicians who access specialist advice through the eConsult BASE[™] Managed Specialty option can now ask COVID-19 vaccine allergy related clinical questions to the new COVID-19 Vaccine Allergy/Immunology BASE Managed Group of specialists and receive a response within days. Please note that this group cannot answer questions about vaccine distribution. More information on this new managed group of specialists

eConsult Through Your EMR

eConsult is available to physicians in two ways – through the OTNhub or through your EMR. Physicians told us that they prefer access through their EMRs because it fits better with their workflow. If you use Accuro® EMR, Avaros EMR or YES EMR, you can get access to eConsult today to request a specialist's advice by contacting support@ontariomd.com. If you use another EMR, please tell your vendor know that you want access to eConsult. OntarioMD can work with your vendor to make it happen so you can get specialist advice for your patients sooner and integrate it into your EMR.

ONE Mail Direct Retirement

If you use ONE Mail Direct, you may have received an initial communication from Ontario Health to tell you that this secure email service is being retired in 2021. Ontario Health will follow up with another communication with details about a new secure email service from a third party recommended by Ontario Health and giving you 90 days to migrate to this new service or select an alternate service. We will update users as we receive more information.
