More and more Ontarians are getting vaccinated to protect against COVID-19 and primary care clinicians need to know which of their patients have been vaccinated and which have not. Last month, we updated readers on HRM's delivery of COVID-19 vaccination reports from the provincial COVaxON system to your EMRs. It wasn't perfect at launch, but we're catching up and will soon be delivering more reports to your EMR inbox. Dr. Chandi Chandrasena, OMD's Chief Medical Officer (CMO) recommends that you visit the [latest news on HRM-COVaxON and other sources of COVID-19 vaccination data](#). Find out how to get vaccination reports based on your practice model. ## Digital Health and Virtual Care Tools

### Access to the Digital Health Drug Repository from Your EMR Has Started!

The first certified EMR has been integrated with the provincial Digital Health Drug Repository (DHDR). Clinicians using YMS EMR, offered by YMS Inc., can launch the DHDR seamlessly and securely from within the EMR, which better suits their workflow. Direct access from EMRs allows them to spend more time addressing their patients' needs instead of logging in and navigating multiple online tools. Providing clinicians with dispensed medications decreases the risk of patient adverse drug events such as medication errors, drug reactions, allergic reactions, and overdoses to keep their patients safe. COVID-19 vaccination information is also included in the DHDR view, providing another tool in the battle to control the pandemic. OMD, Ontario Health, the Ministry of Health, and YMS Inc. worked on this together.



### eForms Are Coming!



Completing and submitting forms from your EMR is about to get easier! Ontario Ministry of Transportation (MTO) Driver Medical Review (DMR) (aka "fitness to drive") forms are the first forms used by clinicians that have been integrated between the provincial digital forms platform and a certified EMR. The first physician, a YMS EMR user, is already using the DMR form. This milestone is an OMD collaboration with Ontario Health, MTO and YMS. The digital forms platform is flexible to support a wide variety of health-related forms, as well as future integration with HRM for direct filing of form submissions into the patient's chart in your EMR.

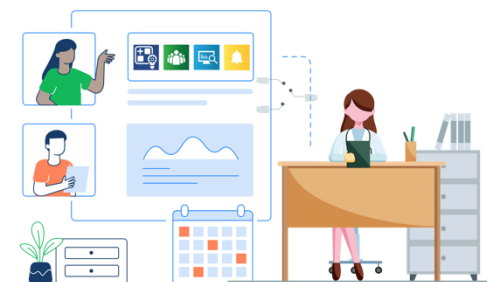

**Are You Moving? HRM Needs to Know Where You Are!**

Just like the post office, HRM needs to know where to deliver your reports. Planning an office move? Switching to another Internet provider? Making a change to your Internet plan? Choosing a new EMR provider? These scenarios could potentially mean a change to your IT delivery location. A change in location will disrupt your HRM feed and you will stop receiving reports from hospitals and specialty clinics. HRM only delivers to locations it trusts, so if any of these scenarios apply to you **don't forget to notify OntarioMD** at [support@ontariomd.com](mailto:support@ontariomd.com) and allow for a **minimum of 7 business days** from the time we receive your complete request with a valid IP address to ensure you don't experience any disruption to HRM report delivery.
