From the CMO's Desk: OMD's Latest Advocacy Work



OMD is always working to give clinicians a better user experience. We work closely with the OMA and advocate for integrated EMRs and workflows:

- Axe the Fax OMD is advocating that you can't "axe the fax" without having seamless and integrated solutions. Stopping fax is not a solution if we can't find workflows to decrease the overall administrative burden.
- Health Report Manager (HRM®) Task Force OMD is leading the HRM Task Force to identify
 pain points for community clinicians using HRM. We are working with all key stakeholders to
 create a sending facility standard for reports sent from hospitals.
- **OMA Forms Committee** We know forms are a source of frustration so we're looking at ways to automate and streamline them.
- SADIE (Special Authorization Digital Information Exchange) We're talking to the Ministry of Health to enable you to submit electronic requests from your EMR instead of a portal to the Ontario Drug Benefit Program's Exceptional Access Program, and track Ministry decisions.

HRM Delivering Patient Interaction Notes from Health Connect Ontario

The Ministry of Health and Ontario Health have launched <u>Health Connect Ontario</u> (HCO), a new service that allows patients to call 811 or chat online with a registered nurse and find the health care services and information they need all in one, easy-to-use website. HRM is contributing to this enhanced provincial service by delivering patient interaction notes (as PDFs) to the family physicians of patients who use HCO as of April 22. This will enhance continuity of care by keeping the family physicians informed of the clinical

reason for the call and the nurses' recommendations/triage. If you still don't have HRM, contact OMD at support@ontariomd.com to request it.

COVaxON Training: Changes to Clinical Flow Coming

The Ministry of Health is releasing a new version of the COVaxON vaccine management system on June 8, 2022. The new COVaxON Clinical Flow Modernization includes improvements that will streamline workflow for primary care practices, but due to time and resources, the tool is still not integrated with clinicians' EMRs. The OMA and OMD continue to advocate with the Ministry for a fully EMR-integrated vaccine management solution. We recognize that many physicians will not be able to do COVID-19 vaccines in their practices. If you have previously used, and wish to continue to use COVaxON, OMD is



retraining clinicians on the new workflow. We're also training practices that wish to start COVID-19 vaccinations with complete end-to-end training. Check out the new training dates and other COVID-19 supports on our website.

Are You Moving? HRM Needs to Know Where You Are!

Just like the post office, HRM needs to know where to deliver your reports. Moving? Switching Internet providers? Changing your Internet plan? Choosing a new EMR provider? These scenarios could potentially mean a change to your IT delivery address disrupting your HRM feed and stopping your reports from hospitals and specialty clinics. HRM only delivers to locations it trusts, so **don't forget to notify OMD** at support@ontariomd.com when making a change. We need a minimum of 7 business days from the time we receive your complete request with a valid IP address to ensure you don't experience any disruptions to report
