From the CMO's Desk: Backdated COVaxON Reports



At the end of March, the delivery of 750,000 **backdated** COVID-19 vaccination reports via Health Report Manager (HRM[®]) from the COVaxON system to clinicians' EMRs was paused. Backdated reports are reports that were NOT entered into COVaxON at the time the vaccine was administered. They were entered later and were for first and second doses of the vaccine. Report delivery was paused due to issues with dose information. Other reports you receive through HRM were not affected.

It's now the middle of July so you may be wondering what's happening with the backdated reports. The issue with the reports has been fixed and they can be sent soon. **Do clinicians still want the reports after all this time?**

OMD thought it best to ask the primary care community about this because it's not our decision to make. **If you're a family physician and use HRM, please click the button below** to tell us if you would like to receive the backdated reports or not. We will advise Ontario Health of the results of this poll (**closes Monday, July 25**).

Update to the CPSO's Virtual Care Policy



The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario recently approved a new <u>Virtual</u> <u>Care Policy</u> and associated <u>Advice to the Profession document</u>. The Policy is effective as of June 2022 and replaces the previous CPSO <u>Telemedicine</u> policy. The new Policy clarifies:

- When virtual care is appropriate
- Requirements during the first virtual encounter
- Appropriate technology and setting for virtual care
- Consent and confidentiality requirements

Coming this Summer: eForms for Avaros EMR and EMR Advantage Users

Avaros EMR and EMR Advantage are finishing the last steps of their integration with <u>eForms</u> in the next month. eForms are digital forms you can complete from the convenience of your EMR. You no longer have to complete paper forms for faxing to various organizations, only to have them be sent back to you because they were outdated versions, or something was missing. eForms are taking off in Ontario. There are currently 16 forms from the Ministry of Transportation available and more forms are coming!

Just like the post office, HRM needs to know where to deliver your reports. Moving? Switching Internet providers? Changing your Internet plan? Choosing a new EMR? These scenarios could potentially mean a change to your IT delivery address, disrupting your HRM feed and stopping your reports from hospitals and specialty clinics. HRM only delivers to locations it trusts, so don't forget to notify OMD at support@ontariomd.com when making a change. We need a minimum of 7 business days from the time we receive your complete request with



a valid IP address to ensure you don't experience any disruptions to report delivery.
