How they complement each other

HRM and **ClinicalConnect** are two ehealth tools that offer health care providers different ways to access electronic health information.


HRM

is an Ontario-wide solution that **delivers** clinical reports into clinicians' certified electronic medical records (EMRs).

ClinicalConnect

is a secure web-based portal or **viewer** solution, providing real-time access to patient information from across south west Ontario (SWO).

These individual ehealth tools allow users to receive (**HRM**) critical information in an easy-to-use format or to access (**ClinicalConnect**), and together provide a more complete patient view.

Download Connection

 Reports pushed directly to clinicians' EMRs within minutes of transcription

Practitioner-Based

Reports selected where the practitioner is copied

Hospital + Other Reports / Medical Information

- Medical Record Reports
 - e.g. Discharge Summaries
- Diagnostic Imaging Reports
 - e.g. Mammograms
- eNotifications
 - Discharge from Emergency Department
 - Admission / discharge from in-patient units
- Ontario Telemedicine Network Telehomecare Reports
- Specialty Clinic Reports
 - Cardiology
 - Radiology

EMR-Based

 Records accessed from certified EMRs anywhere with internet connection

 - 1 specialty clinic
- Provincially
 - 157 hospitals
 - 42 specialty clinics
 - 6 Community Care Access Centres (CCACs)

Future Scope of Data Contributors

All eligible Ontario hospitals, specialty clinics and other CCACs



Viewer Service

 Clinicians log into web portal; reports pulled on demand based on search queries

Patient-Based

 All patient reports, regardless if the practitioner was copied or not
