


Local EMR Offering – Configuration 1

Physical server for each practice location

The EMR is implemented on local technology at each practice location which includes a local server that resides on its own internal local area network (LAN). The server is shared among all physicians within the practice, and must be implemented at the practice's physical location.






Local EMR Offering – Configuration 2

One local server supports all the practice locations

Local single server technology resides physically in one of the practice locations, and supports the needs of all of the participating physicians in the practice, no matter how many locations the practice occupies. This configuration supports file access and sharing among member locations, via a single patient database located physically at one of the practice location.





Local Offering – Configuration 3

One server located in a hospital supports all the group's locations

The server resides physically in a local hospital at the request of the group, and supports the needs of all of the participating physicians, no matter how many locations the group occupies. This configuration supports file access and sharing among member locations via a single patient database. Management of this configuration may be contracted to the hospital IT department.
