## Abstract: \*

Lung cancer is the most commonly diagnosed cancer and is the leading cause of cancer deaths. Interventions to reduce tobacco use should lessen the lung cancer disease burden as tobacco use contributes to 85% of lung cancers.

EMR tools can assist physicians and other clinicians to identify patients at risk for lung cancer. These tools can assist with interventions for smoking cessation, and risk reduction at home and at work. High risk lung cancer screening is a program to identify cancer earlier in the hope of lessening death and morbidity.

Patients with lung cancer are often diagnosed at late stages of the disease and early palliative care can improve their quality of care. EMR tools for palliative care guide clinicians to provide comprehensive high quality palliative care.
