### **Did you know?**

#### **New Hospital Sites in Southwest Ontario Now Sending eNotifications**

Earlier this month, 12 hospital sites in southwest OntarioMD began sending eNotifications to physicians across Ontario. An eNotification is a near real-time electronic message sent through HRM® to primary care providers to notify them when their patients are discharged from the Emergency Department or are admitted or discharged from in-patient units. They also signal that additional reports will be arriving **in your EMR via HRM**.
