

HRM and Your Static IP Address

Planning an office move? Switching to another Internet provider? Making a change to your Internet plan? Those scenarios could potentially mean a change to your static IP address. A change in static IP address will affect your HRM feed if you are using a certified local EMR solution. HRM uses a network firewall that will only allow trusted IP addresses to connect to it. Any changes to a device's IP address must go through the standard firewall change request process. Don't forget to notify OntarioMD at support@ontariomd.com as soon as possible to ensure you don't experience any disruption to HRM report delivery.
