

Depression PHQ9 Screening Status

I4C Indicator CDM-DEP-001: Depression PHQ9 Screening Status v 2.0

Category: CDM/Depression

Purpose:

This indicator is used to identify patients with major depression who have not been screened with a patient health questionnaire (PHQ-9) in the past 12 months.

Source:

Based on the HQO Quality Standards for Major Depression: Comprehensive Assessment, Monitoring for Treatment and Response, Published 2016 and adapted for clinical use as a QIP measure by the Northeastern Family Health Teams Network (NEOFHT).

Base Population:

All patients with an Active demographic status recorded in the EMR who have a confirmed major depression diagnosis through entry of an appropriate diagnosis code.

Indicator Segments:

Depression with documented PHQ9 in the past 12 months: Count of patients with major depression AND WITH a completed PHQ-9 assessment documented within the past 12 months.

Depression without documented PHQ9 in the past 12 months: Count of patients with major depression AND WITHOUT a completed PHQ-9 assessment documented within the past 12 months.

Patients are identified with having major depression through the entry of any of the following diagnosis codes within the current diagnosis/problem section of the cumulative patient profile:

Physician or practice use of this indicator is to identify or recall patients with major depression who have not completed a PHQ-9 assessment within the past year.
