

Meningococcal Vaccination

I4C Indicator PHC-IMM-006: Meningococcal Vaccination v 1.1

Category: Preventive Health Care/Immunizations

Purpose:

This indicator is used to identify patients who aren't immunized for Meningitis.

Source:

Based on the HQO indicator framework version published October 2015.

Base Population:

All patients age 11-13 years old with an Active demographic status recorded in the EMR.

Indicator Segments:

Immunization Received: Count of patients age 11 to 13 years WITH a meningococcal conjugate vaccine documented as 'administered'.

Immunization Overdue: Count of patients age 11 to 13 years WITHOUT a meningococcal conjugate vaccine documented as 'administered'.

Suggested Indicator Use:

Physician or practice use of this indicator is to identify or recall patients who have not received a meningococcal conjugate vaccine.
