

Preventive Care Bonus Influenza Immunization

i4C Indicator RPT-BNS-005: Preventive Care Bonus Influenza Immunization v 2.1

Category: Reporting/Care Bonus

Purpose:

This indicator is used to review the percentage of patients meeting the criteria for the preventive care bonus.

Source:

Not derived from any primary care reporting framework; introduced during the EMR Physician Dashboard Proof of Concept to support clinicians tracking eligibility for submitting cumulative preventive care bonus codes.

Base Population:

All enrolled patients who are 65 years of age or older as of December 31 of the fiscal year for which the bonus is being claimed.

Indicator Segments:

Influenza up to date: Count of enrolled patients age 65 years and older as of Dec 31 of the current fiscal year WITH an Influenza Immunization documented as 'administered' prior to Jan 31 of the current flu season OR WITH a Q130A tracking code submitted for the patient between Sept 30 and Jan 31 of the current flu season.

Influenza overdue: Count of enrolled patients age 65 years and older as of Dec 31 of the current fiscal year WITHOUT an Influenza Immunization documented as 'administered' prior to Jan 31 of the current flu season AND WITHOUT a Q130A tracking code submitted for the patient between Sept 30 and Jan 31 of the current flu season.

Current flu season begins Sep 30 and ends Mar 31 of the current fiscal year.

Current fiscal year begins Apr 1 of the *previous* calendar year and ends on Mar 31 of the *current* calendar year (if the current date is earlier than Apr 1 of the calendar year) else begins Apr 1 of the *current* calendar year and ends Mar 31 of the *next* calendar year.

Suggested Indicator Use:

Physician or practice use of this indicator is to determine the preventive care bonus for which the physician is eligible to claim. This indicator should not be used for patient care or to identify patients overdue for immunization.
